

2025 UPLIFT VIDEOGRAPHY CONTRACT

For Neil Shewmaker under BAMFAM Films, LLC

1. OVERVIEW

- 1.1. The following contract confirms the signee's position as a 1099-NEC Independent Contractor for BAMFAM Films, LLC (Studio). The signee of this contract shall hereafter be identified as (Partner). Once signed by all parties, this document (Contract) shall be legally binding and enforceable under the laws of the United States.
- 1.2. A stated goal of this agreement and opportunity is for Partner to "test the waters" with Studio to better determine the possibility of a long-term, salaried partnership.

2. SERVICES

- 2.1. Partner will operate as the primary editor for daily recap videos and a longer session recap video, receiving footage from Studio to edit throughout the day and deliver by the required deadline.
- 2.2. Partner offers their skills to potentially shoot with Studio's camera if desired or needed.

3. COMMITMENTS

- 3.1. Partner commits to leverage their creativity, skills, and film passion to create exciting and novel videos for Uplift campers.
- 3.2. Partner commits to maintain clear, quick communication in all manners. Studio expects Partner to aim for responding within one business day.

4. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

- 4.1. Partner relinquishes all intellectual property rights to works created for Studio, unless otherwise stated in a written contract.

5. COMPENSATION

- 5.1. Partner will receive a minimum of \$550/week.
- 5.2. Studio will secure and pay for Partner's flights and other travel expenses to and from Searcy.
- 5.3. Partner will be provided with housing and food during the duration of Uplift's two sessions.
 - 5.3.1. Partner will independently source meals on off days between sessions. Studio may provide a complimentary team meal on off days, but is not required to.

6. VALUES

6.1. Studio highly values these attributes: attention to detail, positivity, and problem-solving. These values come with the following expectations:

6.1.1. Attention to Detail: Partner agrees to carefully follow instructions and thoroughly review work for errors before completion.

6.1.2. Positivity: Partner agrees to approach this role with a positive mindset and attitude, regarding the health and success of the work culture with a sense of responsibility.

6.1.3. Problem Solving: Partner agrees to consistently think: "If I were in charge here, what would I do? How can I move forward? Is there another way to approach this?" In all situations, Partner agrees to go the extra mile in problem-solving solutions.

7. FEDERAL REPORTING

7.1. Partner will supply a W9 form for proper IRS filing upon request.

8. TERM & TERMINATION

8.1. This contract shall begin on the date of signing and continue until final payment to Partner is completed.

8.2. Either party may terminate this agreement at any time by providing written notice (email is acceptable).
